HIS CONCEPTION AND MOTHER

Prophecy: 'A virgin shall conceive and bear a son' (Isaiah 7:14)

Fulfilment: "The angel said unto her, Fear not, Mary: for.. you shall conceive in your womb, and bring forth a son, and shall call his name ישוע - JESUS.. Then said Mary unto the angel, How shall this be, seeing I know not a man?" (Luke 2:30-34)

PLACE OF BIRTH & ANOINTING

Prophecy: 'Bethlehem.. out of you shall he come forth unto me that is to be ruler in Israel;' (Micah 5:2)

Fulfilment: "Jesus was born in Bethlehem.." (Matthew 2:1) "the Lord God shall give unto him the throne of his father David.. and of his kingdom there shall be no end." (Luke 1:32,33)

HIS EARLY YOUTH

Prophecy: 'Out of Egypt have I called my son.' (Hosea 11:1)

Fulfilment: "the angel of the Lord appears to Joseph in a dream, saying, Arise, and take the young child and his mother, and flee into **Egypt**.. for Herod will seek the young child to destroy him. .. And was there until the death of Herod." (Matthew 2:13-15)

HIS MESSAGE

Prophecy: 'preach good tidings unto the meek.. bind up brokenhearted, proclaim liberty to the captives..' (Isaiah 61:1)

Fulfilment: "Then Jesus answering said unto them, Go your way, and tell John what things you have seen and heard; how that the blind see, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, to the poor the gospel is preached." (Luke 7:22)

THE BRIBE FOR HIS BETRAYAL Prophecy: 'I took the thirty pieces of silver, and cast them to the potter in the house of the LORD.' (Zechariah 11:13)

Fulfilment: "What will ye give me, and I will deliver him unto you? And they covenanted with him for **thirty pieces of silver**. Then



Judas, which had betrayed him, when he saw that he (Jesus) was condemned, repented himself, And he cast down the pieces of silver in the temple.. and they took counsel and bought with them the

potter's field." (Matthew 27:3-7)

HE WAS DESPISED

Prophecy: 'rejected of men; a man of sorrows.. we hid as it were our faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not.' (Isaiah 53:3)

Fulfilment: "He came unto his own but his own received him not." (John 1:11) "But they cried out, Away with him, away with him, crucify him."(John 19:15)

HIS SUFFERING

Prophecy: 'But he was wounded for our transgressions, the Lord has laid on him the iniquity of us all.. with his stripes we are healed.. he opened not his mouth, he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter.. for the transgression of my people was he stricken..' (Isaiah 53:5-9)

Fulfilment: "For this is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many for the **remission of sins**." (Matthew 26:28) "In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins:" (Colossians 1:14)

HIS CLOTHES

Prophecy: 'They part my garments among them, and cast lots upon my vesture.' (Psalms 22:18)

Fulfilment: "Then the soldiers.. took his garments, and made four parts, to every soldier a part; and also his coat: now the coat was without seam, woven from the top throughout. They said therefore among themselves, Let us not rend it, but cast lots for it." (John 19:23,24)

HIS EXECUTION

Prophecy: 'they have pierced my hands and

my feet.' (Psalms 22:16) (This remarkable prophecy was given by King David, who lived around 1000 B.C.



Crucifixion was invented more than 600 years afterwards by the Persians circa 350 B.C. It was later 'perfected' by the Romans.)

Fulfilment: "But he *(Thomas)* said unto them, Except I shall see in his hands the print of the nails, and put my finger into the print of **the nails**, and thrust my hand into his side, I will not believe." (John 20:25)

THE EXACT YEAR OF HIS DEATH

Prophecy: 'After 62 sevens shall the Messiah be cut off, but not for himself..' (Daniel 9:26) (Seven is שבוע - shavua, or seven as timeframe. In this prophecy it fits seven years.)

Fulfilment: 62 times 7 years equals 434 years after the rebuilding of Jerusalem, which was completed in 405 B.C. This brings us to the year of his crucifixion; 29 A.D.

The year of Jesus' birth was 4 B.C., as is confirmed in other historical writings. Thus he was crucified at the age of 33. [The people who understood this '70 sevens' prophecy in Daniel 9:24-27 were waiting for the Messiah in the temple. "Simeon.. took.. him (Jesus) up in his arms.. Lord, now let your servant depart in peace. For mine eyes have seen your salvation.. And there was Anna, and she coming in.. spoke of him (Jesus) to all them that looked for redemption." (Luke 2:25-38)

"Philip finds Nathanael, and says.. **We have found him** of whom <u>Moses in the law, and the prophets,</u> <u>did write</u>, Jesus of Nazareth.." (John 1:45)]

HIS BONES

Prophecy: 'He keeps all his bones: not one of them is broken.' (Psalms 34:20)

Fulfilment: "Then came the soldiers, and broke the legs of the first, and of the other which was crucified with him. But when they came to Jesus, and saw that he was dead already, **they broke not his legs**" (John 19:32,33)

HIS RESURRECTION

Prophecy: 'God will not leave his soul in the grave, neither will he suffer his Holy One to see corruption and decay' (Psalms 16:10) 'in the third day he will raise up..' (Hosea 6:2) Fulfilment: "the angel said to the women, Fear not: for I know that you seek Jesus, which was crucified. He is not here: for he is risen.. go quickly, and tell his disciples that he is risen from the dead.." (Matthew 28:5) One of the disciples talking, "we trusted that it had been he which should have redeemed Israel: and beside all this, today is the third day since these things were done. Yea, and certain women also of our company made us astonished, which were early at the sepulchre saying, that they had also seen a vision of angels, which said that he was alive." (Luke 24:21-23)

BREAD AND WATER

Prophecy: 'Ho, every one that thirsts, come to the waters.. Wherefore do you spend money for that which is not bread?' (Isaiah 55:1,2)

Fulfilment: "And Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: he that comes to me shall never hunger; and he that believes on me shall never thirst." (John 6:35) If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink. He that believes on me, <u>as the scripture has said</u>, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water." (John 7:37,38)

First Judaic writings: the five books of Moses from around 1500 B.C. till the book of Malachi approx. 400 B.C.

The prophet Isaiah wrote concerning the prophecies in our scriptures:



'Seek ye out of the book of the LORD, and read: not one of these shall fail, none shall want her mate..' (Isaiah 34:16) In other words; none of the prophecies shall fail and the mate of each prophecy is her fulfilment.

The single most important person that was prophesied about was our חמשיח, our Mashiach, or the Messiah.

We'll study some of the hundreds of prophecies about this Messiah and see their mate, or fulfilment.
