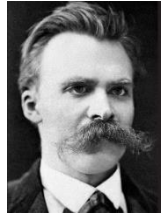


Can a Dead God damage our Brain?

Let's just be careful that our life does not end in disillusionment, as it did with Friedrich Nietzsche, the German philosopher who said that "Gott ist tot" or God is dead. The poor fellow had a [mental breakdown](#) for the last

eleven years of his life. That means he died at the age of fifty-six, so he pretty much lost it at the age of forty-five.

Dr Vilayanur Ramachandran of the University of California in San Diego said that the phenomena of **religious belief in God is "hard-wired" in our brain.**

Could this heretofore unidentified part of the brain -- nicknamed the "**God module**" -- actually be some sort



of physiological seat of religious belief? The scientists who discovered it believe it might be. The scientists said that although the research and its conclusions are preliminary, initial results suggest that the phenomenon of religious belief is "hard-wired" into the brain.¹

With this in mind it might be wiser not to fight against the existence of God too much; we could damage our brains like poor Friedrich, as religious belief seems to be 'hardwired' up there.

What started out as a philosophical satirical prank against God and [his word](#), snowballed. The theory hit the high lights - "[another best seller for the age of enlightenment.](#)" The little prank windup truck ballooned into a juggernaut. The author enjoyed his popularity and excitedly tried to control the acceleration.

However, [the truck-owner had removed the brakes](#) and the whole rig raced downhill,



uncontrollably picking up breakneck speed towards the capital. The truck ran over people in the market place and left many dead, as their faith was killed by this popular, irrational-philosophical steam-roller. Finally, the truck crashed. The pamphlets from the truck flew everywhere; people picking them up and reading, what this drama was all about. The crash also killed the reckless authors who could not stop the lorry and these are some of their last words.²

Thomas Paine (1737-1809 Leading atheistic writer in American colonies) "Stay with me, for God's sake; I cannot bear to be left alone, O Lord, help me! O God, what have I done to suffer so much? What will become of me hereafter? I would give worlds if I had them, that 'the Age of Reason' had never been published. O Lord, help me! Christ, help me! No, don't leave; stay with me! Send even a child to stay with me; for I am on the edge of hell here alone. If ever the Devil had an agent, I have been that one."

Sir Francis Newport (1555-1623 Head of an English Atheist club), to those gathered around his deathbed: "You need not tell me there is no God, for I know there is one, and that I am in his presence! You need not tell me there is no hell. I feel myself already slipping. Wretches, cease your idle talk about there being hope for me! I know I am lost forever! Oh, that fire! Oh, the insufferable pangs of hell! Oh, that I could... purchase the favour of God and be united to Him again. But it is a fruitless wish..."

Voltaire (1694-1778 Famous French philosopher and writer) "I am abandoned by God and man." He said to his physician, Dr Fochin: "I will give you half of what I am worth if you will give me six months of life." When he was told this was impossible, he said, "Then I shall die and go to hell!" (*His nurse said: "For all the money in Europe I wouldn't want to see another unbeliever die! All night long he cried for forgiveness."*)

David Hume (1711-1776 Atheist philosopher famous for his religious scepticism) ... He cried loud on his death bed "I am in flames!" It is said his desperation was a horrible scene.

Thomas Scott (Privy councillor of James V. of Scotland) "Until this moment I thought there was neither a God nor a hell. Now I know and feel that there are both, and I am doomed to perdition by the just judgment of the Almighty."

Josef Stalin (His [Great Purge](#) killed millions) Svetlana, his daughter, told Newsweek: "My father died a terrible death... he suddenly opened his eyes and cast a glance over everyone in the room. It was a terrible glance, insane... bringing down a curse on us all. It was full of menace... next morning, he was dead."

Napoleon Bonaparte (1769-1821 French emperor) He brought death to millions to satisfy his ... selfish ambitions for world conquest. "I die before my time, and my body will be given back to the earth. Such is the fate of him who has been called the great Napoleon. What an abyss between my deep misery and the eternal kingdom of Christ!"

Anton LaVey (1930-1997 Author of *'The Satanic Bible'* and high priest of the Satanic worship religion.) ... His dying words were: "Oh my, oh my, what have I done, there is something very wrong."

GENEVA - CERN Conseil Européen pour la Recherche Nucléaire

Gunther Scheizle (German nuclear physicist and professor at the Department of Physics at the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology, in Zurich - ETHZ) surprised his colleagues this week when he revealed his faith in God.³ forcing him to reconsider his "previous understanding of life



and the universe." "I can understand my coworkers' surprise, I have always been known as somewhat of a

no-nonsense, anti-religious atheist. **I once threw a heavy physics book at one of my students just because he even mentioned the possibility of**

Intelligent Design in the universe. I guess he was right after all," he acknowledged with a grin.

The 57-year-old experienced a heart attack during one of the most powerful tests to be done on the large hadron collider yet. "We tried to push the hadron collider's limits that day and beat our record of 6.5 tera-electron-volts (TeV) per beam and that is when I started to feel uneasy and eventually lost consciousness," he recalls.

"Although I was unconscious and my body lay paralyzed on the floor, I felt like I was outside my body and could hear and see all the commotion my heart failure had caused around me," he explains. "That is when beings of light came and comforted me. They did not say anything, but I knew I was going to survive and that my mission on earth had not yet been accomplished. I knew I was not dead. All I remember after that, is waking up in the ambulance in excruciating pain.

All my preconceived notions of reality were permanently destroyed."

"How could I face my fellow coworkers and family with such an incoherent story?"

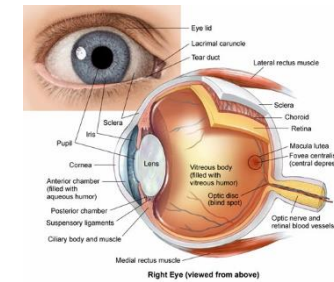

Death... and then What?

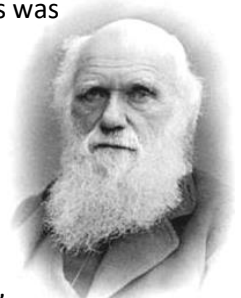
