The Lord blessed Steve for that statement, because he departed from this world with a sense of wonder, saying, 'Oh wow. Oh wow. Oh wow.'

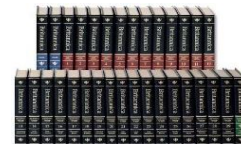
If Steve Jobs does not like on-off switches, neither will God just flip the switch on us.
