We find more details in Luke's Gospel who himself was a physician and he wanted to know the details of what actually happened and took place.

'And the angel said unto her, Fear not, Mary: for you hast found favour with God. And behold, you shall conceive in your womb, and bring forth a son, and shall call his name JESUS. He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: and the Lord God shall give unto him the throne of his father David...' Then said Mary to the angel,

'How shall this be, seeing I know not a man?'

And the angel answered and said unto her, '**The Holy Ghost shall come upon you, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow you: therefore, also that holy thing which shall be born of you shall be called**

the Son of God.' (Luke 1:30-35) And Mary said, 'Behold the handmaid of the Lord; be it unto me according to your word.' And the angel departed from her. (Luke 1:38)



Amazingly Mary did not argue: 'But what will Joe say, they'll throw me out of the house, they'll stone me, no thanks, find someone else.' Nothing of the sort. Only total trust and surrender. Unbelievably beautiful. She sure is to be venerated and honoured for this, as within her Jewish culture of the time, by saying this, she had actually signed her death warrant.

She then went 'with haste' (Luke 1:39) to Elisabeth, who in her old age, was in the sixth month with John the Baptist so, she'd understand Mary's pregnancy. At least there she would be safe for now.

(In the Old Testament the Holy Spirit was female, but in the New Testament due to lack of knowledge of the Hebrew, which was considered a dead language in the 15th and 16th century and also lack of understanding of the Aramaic language which Jesus spoke, we have a <u>translation</u> <u>discrepancy</u> where the Holy Spirit transgendered from female in the original languages, into male gender. Please read <u>'Why the need for the Holy Spirit</u>', in which this dilemma is clearly explained.) Now we understand what happened; the Holy Spirit possessed Mary and the power of the Highest that is the Father overshadowed the Holy Spirit who was within Mary. The egg-cell or ovum in Mary's Body was also taken over by the Holy Spirit and this was inseminated by the Father. The Holy Spirit and the Father had to use Mary's body to give Jesus a physical body, so that we could see him, feel him and touch him within our four-dimensional parameters. That is why Jesus was God in human form and had such a formidable strong link with his Father.

For this reason, Jesus could do what he did.

He was completely fearless, turned water into wine, overruled the nitty-picky Sabbath laws, calmed the storm, fed the thousands, touched and healed lepers, opened the eyes of the blind, caused dumb to speak, raised the dead back to life, healed severe mental health issues, walked on water, several times he'd singlehandedly clear out the temple of money grabbers, and when it came to his crucifixion he could say to his Father, 'not my will but yours be done.' He surrendered totally to the Father, hence his power.

Of his heavenly Mother, Jesus said: All sins shall be forgiven unto the sons of men, and blasphemies... But he that shall blaspheme against the Holy Ghost has never forgiveness, but is in danger of eternal damnation: For they said, 'He has an unclean spirit.' Isn't that a true Son standing up for his mother. 'I don't care what you say about me, but let's get one thing straight, don't you dare talk bad about my mother, because you won't be forgiven.'

Right at that time his mother and brothers show up; Because he was just defending the importance of his heavenly mother, he said, 'Who is my mother, or my brethren? Whoever shall do the will of God, the same is my brother, and my sister, and mother.' (Mark 3:28-35) But, even on the cross Jesus cared for Mary and his last wish before dying was, that she should take John as her son instead, so he'd care of her' (John 19:26,27)

Is there any scientific proof for this Conception?



(Ronald Eldon Wyatt was a nurse anaesthetist; he became an independent archaeologist, intending to find historical proof for the Bible.) I have edited parts of Ron's report in the pamphlet: '<u>The Ark of the</u> <u>Covenant Awaits</u>.'

In the chamber, Ron noticed <u>a dried</u>, **black substance** in an earthquake crack in the roof, above the Ark of the Covenant. He noticed that this black
