All Jesus needed to do was worship the giver. But Jesus answered him 'It is written, you shall worship the Lord your God, and him only shall you serve.'

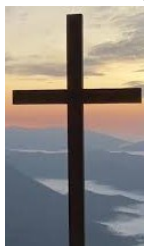

We have many forms of pride but spiritual pride is the worst. I can smell it a mile away; we get smug, and think that we are God's gift to mankind. We promote the cross to hide ourselves behind it.

The cross was a sadistic, pagan tool to kill people slowly. It's nothing but a false idol of wood, iron or plastic that we worship, if we don't worship the Son of God who gave his life in agony on it for our sins. And we dishonour him by not repenting of our sins of compromise, and by not preaching his full message for which he gave his life. Jesus trailblazed the path to repent and follow him. A.W. Pink evangelized, "The Christian that stops repenting stops growing."

I have not heard mega pastors preach, 'Unless we get on our knees and repent from giving into our temptations and ask the Lord to seriously deliver us from our sins of compromising, we will not be ready for the return of Jesus, which is drawing closer.'

It's only messages in which our weaknesses are glossed over: 'God's grace and mercy is boundless. Jesus said, come unto me all you who labour, are weary and heavy laden and I will give your rest. Abraham said, The Lord, before whom I walk, will send his angel with you, and prosper your way. It is all a matter of being positive and not allowing guilt to ruin your life.'

The great King Hezekiah showed off his riches and see what the prophet Isaiah told him. (Isaiah 39:1-7)

Jesus recorded in the Ethiopian Bible 'They use the language of the sacred, but pursue secular reward.'

As teachers and preachers, we are to live according to what we preach, otherwise we're just hypocrites and should not speak about Jesus; but we have the audacity to take one of his sayings and spin a theory around it that people want to hear, so we get the crowds and the collections are good. Please have at least the decency to tell, that you're omitting what Jesus taught about the deceitfulness of riches, i.e.:

- * The deceitfulness of **riches**, choke the word and we become **unfruitful**.' (Mat 13:22)
- * How hardly shall they that have riches enter into the kingdom of God! (Luke 18:24) He that **forsakes** not all that he has, cannot be my disciple. (Lk.14:33)
- * What shall it profit a man, if he will gain **the whole world**, and lose his own soul? (Mark 8:36; Mat.16:26)
- * **Sell all** that you have, distribute to the poor, and you shall have treasure in heaven: For where **your treasure is**, there will **your heart** be also. (Lk.12:22,34)
- * The **love of money** is the root of all evil. (1Tim.6:10)
- * In 1 hour so **great riches came to nought**. (Re.18:17)

But as we are Christians, and go to church, we think we are safe, because we have the cross, pray, fast and give money, we expect a mansion in heaven.

The Hindus have a swastika; the Muslims have the crescent moon with star and also think they're safe.

They also pray, fast and give money. They also go to their place of worship, their temple or mosque and believe their deity or Allah is pleased with them.

The Jews thought they were safe because they had Abraham as **their father**. Yet, Jesus told them, 'You are of your father the devil.' (John 8:44)

Christians think they are safe because they have the cross and the church as **their mother**. Yet, Jesus told them, 'I never knew you, depart from me;' (Mat.7:23) **"Return thou to me, but she returned not."** (Jer.3:7)

Dear friends, when we stand before Jesus, we cannot tell the Lord, 'But my preacher said'. His response will be simple 'What did I say in my word?'

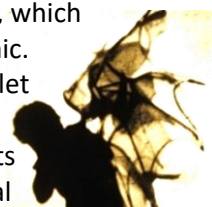

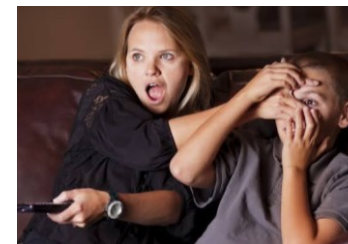
