

Jesus is saying that whatever you need to cut out of your life, be radical, do it; because **hell is not where you want to end up**. Our fires of [anger](#) and hate are quenched here on earth; in hell they are not. These worms and maggots that we invite into our life now, i.e. power-lust, [porn](#), greed, perversion, addiction, hate, lying, apathy, etc., these worms and maggots don't die, but will bore and eat into us constantly. Yet, we are setting our compass for that direction, if we don't repent of our sins. Jesus is love, but he has set boundaries for our sins.

[We pre-destinate](#) where we will spend [our after-life](#).

"Many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to [everlasting life](#), and some to shame and [everlasting contempt](#)." (Dan.12:2) What do we want, be short-sighted and live for today, and be ashamed for eternity, or be happy forever. It's our choice today, not later when we die. **Our choices, set our compass, to our destination.**

There's a Definite Sin that blocks us from heaven.
The greatest mistake any of us can make, is to not **forgive someone**.

I had a tough time with forgiving one person and [the Lord told me](#) clearly: 'Let me handle his heart; you handle your heart. Pass this test, learn to trust me and forgive.' - 'You mean forgive the money?' - "Everything! If you can learn this pearl of a great price, then sell all that you have and **buy this pearl of trust and patience**. Your life and future life depend on it." (Matthew 13:46)

Let's take a look at the Lord, because if we set our compass according to his life, then we are not only [on our way to heaven](#), but we have heaven in our heart today. When they pounded the spikes in Jesus' hands and feet, he said "**Father, forgive them** for they don't know what they are doing." (Luke 23:34)

We look at the most important part of the 'Our Father' prayer that Jesus taught us.



"And forgive us our debts, our trespasses, as we forgive our debtors, those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, ([keep us away from temptation](#)), but deliver us from evil: (the evil of hell if we don't forgive - Matthew 6:12)

For if **we forgive** men their trespasses, our heavenly **Father will also forgive us**: But if **we forgive not** men their trespasses, **neither will our Father** forgive our trespasses. (Matthew 6:14,15)

Peter asked Jesus, "Lord, how often shall I forgive my brother who sins against me; till seven times?" Jesus answers him, "I am not telling you, until seven times: but, until seventy times seven." (Mat.18:21,22) In other words, "**Always, Peter, Always!**"

Then Jesus tells this parable:

"A king took stock of his servants; they brought one to him who owed him **ten thousand talents**. (An impossible amount. **One Talent** equals 6,000 Pence - one pence was a day's wages, or around twenty years of labour. Ten thousand was the top number in the Greek counting system multiplied by talents, the largest unit of currency. The total was running into the billions.)

He couldn't pay this, just like us; we cannot possibly pay for our Salvation, the lord had compassion, and **forgave him the debt**. That same servant went and found a fellow-servant, who owed him a 100-pence: he took him by the throat, saying, 'Pay me what you owe me.' **He cast him into prison**, till he should pay the debt. When his fellow servants saw this, they told it to their lord. Then his lord, after that he had called him in, said unto him, "You unmerciful servant, I forgave you all that debt, because you asked me: **Shouldn't you have had compassion on your fellow servant, even as I had pity on you?**"

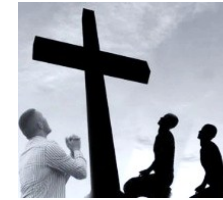
And his lord was very angry, and delivered him to the tormentors (that's hell where demons are the tormentors) till he should pay all that was due unto him. (That's 10,000 times 20 years, as we just learned, which is 200,000 years, in earth's time, of horrendous torment and the paranoia of not knowing what demon comes next out of the thick black, to rip into me.)

So likewise, shall my heavenly Father do also unto you, if you from your hearts forgive not everyone his brother their trespasses. (Matthew 18:23-35)

If you cannot forgive someone, then start the process by saying out loud: 'Jesus hear me; Satan hear me, I forgive so and so.' This is the first step in the right direction of healing. Please read '[Forgiving](#)'.

What about Honouring the Cross?

I thought, 'Lord, shall I get a little silver or gold cross to show that I believe in you?' I never had one and wasn't sure. I used to sing, 'that old rugged cross has a wondrous attraction for me.' The Lord showed me to do some research and I was so



surprised. We look at the cross to give it reverence, but after taking an honest look, it is the most cruel, gruesome device to kill a person in a sadistic way, that can last for days before death. **We say the cross reminds me of Jesus, but then a homeless person or a prisoner should remind us even more of Jesus as they're his brothers, maybe the least but most certainly his brothers.** (Mat.25:40,45) And what we do for them is what we do for Jesus, or do we walk past them on the other side of the street? (Luke 10:30-37)

Rome crucified **6,000 slaves** in 71 BC to strike fear. Josephus (1st century historian) tells us that during the siege of Jerusalem in 70 AD the Romans crucified as many as **500 Jews daily for months to instill fear; submit to Rome, or it's this!** - [Fear versus Faith](#)
The cross was designed by Satan to spread fear.

I started loathing the cross, more than the sword, the electric chair, or the noose. **The cross touches our religious emotions, but does it inspire us to delve into the Word of God, to follow Jesus, to deny ourselves to take up his cross of service daily, and to repent from our sins of compromise?** (Lk.9:23)

It's a Christian symbol, but is it an idol that we carry in a procession, like others carry their idols? Does it lull us into a sleepy sense of security, by thinking, 'We're okay, since we believe in the cross.'

Jesus has another name, he is called 'the Word of God' (Rev.19:13) If we want to be more intimate with Jesus, then we have to study 'the Word of God'- [our Bible](#), by underlining parts and [memorizing verses](#), as this is how the Lord speaks and tries to get our attention. **Jesus is not a shortcut religion of an iron, wooden or plastic cross with lightbulb. "My glory will I not give to another, neither my praise to hand made images - the work of their own hands -"**

(Isa.42:8; 2:8) **Let us not exchange Jesus for a cross.** I almost fell for it and was considering to buy one.

However, it dawned on me that they are opposite; **Jesus is Love, Light and Life; the cross is designed to**

[Matthew](#), [Mark](#), [Luke](#) and [John](#). **Faith grows, not by a cross, but when we absorb 'the living Word of God' (Rom.10:17) and let all the full counsel of his words permeate our life, our soul and actions.**

A prophecy of Jesus in the Ethiopian Bible:

In that prophecy Jesus identifies the most dangerous false prophets of the end-times, as **people that wear crosses and build cathedrals.**

This was removed at the council of Nicaea, 325 AD, as **religious leaders** already wore crosses and built [mega churches](#) /cathedrals, back then.

Religion inoculates us against God calling us; yet, if we are sincere, then [the Holy Spirit](#) will give us the strength from God's Word to fulfil our life's purpose.

We are always looking for a quick fix, as we've got little or no time to study [who Jesus really is](#), so we quickly greet the cross to do our religious duty and we think 'Oh, Poor Jesus' - **NO, it is 'Poor Us'**; Jesus didn't come to start a religion called Christianity with the cross symbol; he lifts us above all religions into the [Kingdom of God](#), with a 3 part constitution [1](#); [2](#); [3](#). **There is no temple or cross in heaven.** (Rev.21:22)



The Energy and Force by which we Exist:

Jesus and God are **here, in us!** 'How?' - Max Planck - Quantum Physicist: 'All matter (including you and me) originates and exists only by virtue of a force (or Energy) that causes atomic particles to vibrate and holds them together. **We must assume a conscious Intelligent Mind exists behind this force**, acting as the [Matrix of all matter](#).' - Thermodynamics states that this Force or this **Energy cannot be created or destroyed that Energy is, and will always be.**

Who does that sound like? Yes, "The Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End, which is, which was, and which is to come, [the Almighty](#)." 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How do we set our Compass for Heaven - with a Cross?



When we receive Jesus, we are spiritually born into eternal life. (John 3:16) **At that time** we leave our old life behind and start our new eternal life. (2Cor.5:17) **And the way we proceed in living from that point on, is the way we set our compass for eternity.**

If I say I love Jesus, but I prefer doing shady deals of darkness, then my destiny will be darkness. If I keep lying, I excuse myself from the heavenly city, as liars are outside. If I keep visiting porn sites, I keep committing adultery (Mat.6:24) then I am also out. **"For outside are dogs, sorcerers, whoremongers, murderers, idolaters, and whoever loves and makes a lie."** (Rev.22:15)

Hell is void of God, who is: Light, Life, Love and Truth so hell is the opposite: Darkness, Death and Hate and Lies. "Life is in the blood" (Lev.17:11) No life, so our blood dries in our veins, our bone-marrow that produces blood, painfully dries out, etc., etc.

Jesus repeats three times: "If your hand, your foot or your eye offend you, remove it, as it is better for you to enter into eternal life maimed, than having all your body parts and go into hell: Where their worm dies not and the fire is not quenched." (Mark 9:43,44)
